

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-\_\_\_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA  
AUTHORIZING THE CONSOLIDATION OF ELECTIONS OF CITY OFFICIALS FOR  
INCORPORATED CITIES, AND DIRECTORS OF SPECIAL DISTRICTS AND SCHOOL  
DISTRICTS WITH THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022**

**WHEREAS**, Tuesday, November 8, 2022 is an established election date on which local jurisdictions may hold elections; and

**WHEREAS**, California Elections Code sections 10400 *et seq.*, as applicable, allow school districts, special districts, and incorporated cities to request consolidation of their elections with the general election; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Shasta Lake, City of Redding, and City of Anderson and the following public entities (collectively, the “Requestors”) have each called for an election in their jurisdiction for the same date and have requested consolidation:

Anderson Union High School District  
Burney Fire Protection District  
Cascade Union Elementary School District  
Clear Creek Community Services District  
Enterprise Elementary School District  
Fall River Joint Unified School District  
Gateway Unified School District  
Millville Elementary School District  
Mountain Gate Community Services  
Red Bluff Joint Union High School District  
Shasta County Board of Education  
Shasta-Tehama-Trinity Joint Community College District  
Shasta Union High School District

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta do hereby authorize the consolidation of the Requestors’ local election with the statewide election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022; and

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Requestors shall comply with all applicable laws regarding the conduct and consolidation of the local elections with the statewide election; and

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that provided that the Requestors calling the local elections and requesting consolidation of their election shall pay their pro-rata share of the costs incurred throughout the conduct of said elections.
