

ORDINANCE NO. 413-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 413 REGULATING THE PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS AND OTHER TRAFFIC SIGNALS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Ordinance No. 413 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION I: The Board of Supervisors may, by resolution, authorize the erection of stop or other traffic signals or markers permitted to be authorized by local authorities under any provision of the Vehicle Code of the State of California. The resolution shall direct the Director of Public Works to place or have placed said stop or other traffic signal or marker in the manner prescribed by said Vehicle Code. The Clerk of said Board shall keep an index of all resolutions authorizing stop signals and signs and an index of all resolutions authorizing other traffic signals of markers.

SECTION II. All stop and other traffic signals and markers erected pursuant to Section I of this ordinance shall meet the specifications for such traffic signals and markers as are set forth in the Vehicle Code of the State of California, and it shall be unlawful for any person to fail to comply with the requirements of such stop or other traffic signals and markers.

SECTION III. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance irrespective of the invalidity of any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases thereof declared unconstitutional or ineffective.

SECTION IV: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION V: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, this ordinance shall be published once, with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against it, in the Record-Searchlight, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Shasta, State of California.


