RESOLUTION NO. 2017-

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA AUTHORIZING THE ADJUSTMENTS IN RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL, AND TRANSFER STATION REFUSE COLLECTION RATES FOR USA WASTE OF CALIFORNIA, INC.

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2012, the Board of Supervisors approved a ten-year franchise agreement between USA Waste of California, Inc. and the County; and

WHEREAS, the agreement allows for adjustments in collection rates according to the change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) and costs for collection and disposal; and

WHEREAS, rate increases in the collection rates may be increased by the percentage change in the CPI U.S. City average for the twelve-month period ending the preceding December and the disposal tipping charge component of the collection rates may be increased for the percentage change above 0.5% of the CPI percentage change for the twelve-month period ending the preceding December; and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2017, a written notice describing the proposed waste collection rate increase was mailed to affected property owners in accordance with the provisions of Article XIIIC and XIIID, of the California Constitution and California Government Code sections 53750; and

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2017, a public hearing was held to provide an opportunity to protest proposed rate increases in accordance with the provisions of Article XIIIC and XIIID, of the California Constitution and California Government Code sections 53750; and

WHEREAS, there was not a majority protest to the proposed increases; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2017, through July 1, 2021, that each July 1st, the collection rates may be adjusted by USA Waste of California, Inc. in accordance with the Solid Waste Collection Agreement between the County of Shasta and USA Waste of California, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the total adjustment of rates permitted in any one year shall not exceed 6%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the Board of Supervisors authorizes USA Waste of California, Inc. to set rates for the period July 1, 2017, through July 1, 2021, provided that the increase does not exceed the maximum allowable monthly rates for residential and commercial waste collection services performed by USA Waste of California, Inc. as described in the Agreement.
