**WHEREAS**, it is of the greatest importance that all citizens fully understand the provisions and principles contained in the Constitution in order to support, preserve, and defend it against all enemies; and

**WHEREAS**, September 17, 2017 marks the two hundred thirtieth anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

**WHEREAS**, the anniversary of the Signing of the Constitution provides an opportunity for all Americans to realize the achievements of the Framers of the Constitution and the rights, privileges, and responsibilities it secured; and

**WHEREAS**, the independence guaranteed to American citizens, whether by birth or naturalization, should be celebrated by appropriate ceremonies and activities during **Constitution Week**, September 17-23, 2017, as designated by proclamation of the President of the United States of America in accordance with Public Law 915.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta hereby proclaims the week of September 17-23, 2017 as **Constitution Week** in Shasta County and urges all our citizens to consider and appreciate the many benefits of our Federal Constitution and American citizenship.
