**WHEREAS**, practicing a home fire escape plan twice a year ensures that everyone in the household knows what to do in a real fire situation; and

**WHEREAS**, Shasta County's first responders are dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through prevention and protection education; and

*WHEREAS*, the 2017 *Fire Prevention Week* theme, "Every Second Counts: Plan 2 Ways Out!" effectively serves to educate the public about the vital importance of developing a home fire escape plan with all members of the household and practicing it twice a year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta hereby proclaims October 8-14, 2017, as **Fire Prevention Week** in Shasta County and urges citizens of Shasta County to develop a home fire escape plan with all members of the household and practice it twice a year, and to participate in the many public safety activities and efforts of Shasta County's fire and emergency services during Fire Prevention Week 2017.
