

**RESOLUTION NO. 2016-**  
**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**  
**OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA**  
**PROCLAIMING THE TERMINATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY FOR THE**  
**DROUGHT**

**WHEREAS**, California Government Code section 8630, Article 14, of the California Emergency Services Act, empowers the Board of Supervisors to proclaim the existence of a local emergency when Shasta County is threatened or likely threatened by the conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property that are or are likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of this County; and

**WHEREAS**, California Government Code section 8558(c) states that a “local emergency” includes the duly proclaimed existence of conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the territorial limits of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 17, 2014, the Governor of the State of California proclaimed a statewide drought emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2014-040 on May 6, 2014, proclaiming a local drought emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors has reviewed the need for continuing the local emergency 33 times since its original proclamation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors adopted its most recent resolution proclaiming the continuation of a local emergency on October 18, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, local water storage, rainfall and water availability are not currently constrained; and

**WHEREAS**, the storage in Shasta Reservoir is near its average for this time of year; and

**WHEREAS**, the California State Water Resources Control Board issued a Notice of Immediate Lifting of Curtailment to permit and license holders having Term 91 as a condition of their water right; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors recognizes that the circumstances that led to the May 6, 2014 proclamation no longer exist.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND PROCLAIMED** that the Board of Supervisors hereby terminates its proclamation of a local emergency for the drought as originally proclaimed in Resolution No. 2014-040.
