**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA
DESIGNATING LOCAL JAILS AS TREATMENT FACILITIES**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill (SB) 568 amends California Penal Code Sections 1369 and 1369.1 to address the problem of the inability of local jails in California to adequately medicate inmates found Incompetent to Stand Trial (IST) and who remain in local custody; and

WHEREAS, California Penal Code Section 1369.1 allows county jails to be designated as “treatment facilities” for the sole purpose of administering antipsychotic medication to persons found IST pursuant to a court order; and

WHEREAS, California Penal Code Section 1369.1 requires concurrence among the County Board of Supervisors, the County Mental Health Director, and the County Sheriff for the county jails to be designated as “treatment facilities” to provide medically approved medication to defendants found to be mentally incompetent and unable to provide informed consent due to mental disorder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta, and that the Shasta County Sheriff, and the Shasta County Mental Health Director concur, and the Board of Supervisors joins in such concurrence, that the Shasta County Main Jail be and hereby are designated as “treatment facilities” to provide medically approved medication to defendants found to be mentally incompetent and unable to provide informed consent due to mental disorder, pursuant to the provisions of the California Penal Code Section 1369.1.
