

ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA
ACCEPTING PREVIOUS OFFERS OF DEDICATION TO THE PUBLIC FOR
ROADS, PUBLIC UTILITIES, AND EMERGENCY FIRE ACCESS/ESCAPE ROADS**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta, State of California, ordains as follows:

1. Pursuant to California Government Code Section 7050, an irrevocable offer of dedication for public purpose may be made.
2. Previously, there have been irrevocable offers to the public for roads, public utilities and emergency fire access/escape roads made to the public that were consented to but not accepted by the Board of Supervisors.
3. This ordinance shall officially accept all previous offers of dedication to the public for roads, public utilities and emergency fire access/escape roads; which meet the following:
 - A. Offers which have not been revoked or formally abandoned by the Board of Supervisors; and
 - B. Offers which have been put to the intended use of the previous offer.
