ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA ACCEPTING PREVIOUS OFFERS OF DEDICATION TO THE PUBLIC FOR ROADS, PUBLIC UTILITIES, AND EMERGENCY FIRE ACCESS/ESCAPE ROADS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta, State of California, ordains as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to California Government Code Section 7050, an irrevocable offer of dedication for public purpose may be made.
- 2. Previously, there have been irrevocable offers to the public for roads, public utilities and emergency fire access/escape roads made to the public that were consented to but not accepted by the Board of Supervisors.
- 3. This ordinance shall officially accept all previous offers of dedication to the public for roads, public utilities and emergency fire access/escape roads; which meet the following:
 - A. Offers which have not been revoked or formally abandoned by the Board of Supervisors; and
 - B. Offers which have been put to the intended use of the previous offer.
