FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR USE OF REDDING CIVIC AUDITORIUM FOR USE AS AN ALTERNATE CARE SITE DURING COVID19 PANDEMIC

This first amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding for Use of Redding Civic Auditorium as an Alternate Care Site During COVID-19 Pandemic ("MOU") is entered into between the County of Shasta, a political subdivision of the State of California, ("County") and Advance Redding, a California corporation ("Advance Redding").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and Advance Redding have previously entered into the MOU that commenced on April 3, 2020, for the purpose of the Redding Civic Auditorium located at 700 Auditorium Drive, Redding, CA 96001, including all parking areas, appurtenances, and improvements therein, for use as an Alternate Care Site ("ACS") in accordance with the directives of the Shasta County Public Health Officer and his or her designees; and

WHEREAS, County and Advance Redding desire to amend the term of the MOU and provide for payment of a use fee, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, the MOU is amended as follows:

- I. Section 2 of the MOU, "Use of Facility" is amended in its entirety as follows:
 - 2. <u>Use of the Facility</u>: Use of the facility shall commence on April 3, 2020 and shall end May 11, 2020.
- VII. Section 18 of the MOU, "Use Fee" is added as follows:
 - 18. <u>Use Fee</u>. County shall pay \$321,227.78 to Advance Redding for the use of the facility which is inclusive of any costs or charges related to County's use of the facility. County shall make payment to Advance Redding no later than June 12th.

III. REAFFIRMATION

In all other respects, the MOU, as amended, and any attachments, remains in full force and effect.

IV. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

The MOU, as amended, and any attachments, constitute the entire understanding between County and Advance Redding.

V. EFFECTIVE DATE

This First Amendment shall be deemed effective as of April 3, 2020.
